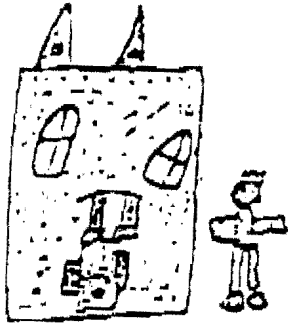


Don,

Dear Mr. Suddeth,

Thank you for selecting our mission for one of your special projects. We are in our 26th year, bringing cancer children and their families to Myrtle Beach in June, July, and August for a free week's vacation. The families are given to me by social workers from 14 hospitals in North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia and Virginia.

We provide accommodations, entertainment and food for the week. We also give each of the approximately 60 families \$300.00 in cash, each child receives a hat, t-shirt and stuffed animal. Occasionally, we have to provide rental car money. Each family also gets a "goodie bag" filled with toys and fun things for the children. We actually put all these items in a Myrtle Beach beach bag.

If you would like to provide our most needed items, they are as follows.

1. Caps--Myrtle Beach logo, any sports related hat, Hannah Montana or any Disney characters.
2. Travel-size hand held games
3. Barbie dolls
4. Matchbox cars
5. Nerf footballs
6. Bubbles
7. Small toys for boys and girls
8. Sand buckets and shovels

Our children range in age from several months to 18 years old.
